



## Keene Family YMCA Member Code of Conduct

The following is the Keene Family YMCA's Member Code of Conduct. The Y promotes the core values of Respect, Responsibility, Caring, and Honesty. We are a family-friendly facility and we have an expectation that the behavior of both our staff and our patrons will always be appropriate and kind.

### **As a member/guest of the Keene Family YMCA I will:**

- Stop at the Welcome Center and check-in upon every visit.
- Refrain from using tobacco/vaping products, alcohol, and/or illegal drugs anywhere on the Y property, including the parking lot.
- Be respectful of Y staff and my fellow members.
- Return found items to the Y Welcome Center.
- Not run in areas not designated for running.
- Refrain from horseplay or behavior that puts myself or someone else in danger.
- Refrain from any activity that could be considered sexual in nature.
- Be responsible for the children and guests that I bring into the building.
- Update my contact information with the Welcome Center if there are any changes.
- Not vandalize the Y's equipment or facilities.
- Not use equipment or facilities inappropriately or for unintended purposes.
- Eat and drink only in the lobby area.
- Never bring a weapon into the Y.
- Understand that glass objects are not permitted anywhere in the building other than the lobby.
- Not wear clothing with inappropriate language or graphics in the Y facility.
- Bring a lock and lock up my personal items.
- Understand that Y staff are the final authority on policy, safety, and behavior.
- Follow age restrictions on facility usage and class caps.
- Understand that physical violence of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Understand that derogatory, racist, sexist, vulgar or belligerent language, profanity, or behavior will not be tolerated.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the activities I am engaging in at the Y.
- Not talk on my cell phone outside of the lobby area.
- Respect time limits on equipment usage.
- Report equipment malfunctions.
- Use safety equipment when engaging in activities that require it.
- Understand that areas marked as closed are off limits for safety reasons and unauthorized use is strictly prohibited.
- Notify Y staff if I become injured or involved in an accident at the Y.
- Understand that I am responsible for my own property and that the Y is not liable for loss or damages to my personal property.
- Understand that camera/recording device use in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited.
